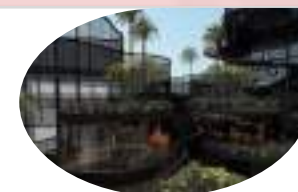
RHYTHM OF LIFE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF THE CONGO

A free shuttle bus service will operate, moving guests between pavilions and venues. Signage will direct guests to the closest station.



FIRST AID AND MEDICAL SERVICES

There will be several medical centres available. In emergency cases, a complimentary ambulance will transfer guests to a government hospital.



VISITOR SERVICES

There are 15 Visitor Services throughout the site. Visitor Services kiosks will feature support staff, digital signage, maps and apps.
